DIRECTOR'S NOTE


In 2019, I was fortunate to direct the pilot production of *Into The Woods SR.*, a collaboration between Music Theatre International (MTI) and Lenox Hill Neighborhood House. The show used the MTI *Broadway Jrs.* condensed version of the Stephen Sondheim-James Lapine classic musical, meant for Middle School students, to explore its value for a cast comprised solely of seniors. The production was successful enough—Sondheim and Lapine visited a rehearsal, the show was written up in a feature in *The New York Times*—to create a second pilot, *Meredith Willson's The Music Man SR.*, and we began rehearsing in the spring of 2020. Roughly halfway through the rehearsal process, the Covid pandemic shut it all down. About three years later, with the pandemic weakening, *The Music Man SR.* project has been revived, featuring many original 2020 cast members, as well as newcomers, and here we are today.

In *Meredith Willson's The Music Man SR*., charismatic salesman Harold Hill exhorts the staid and conservative citizens of River City, lowa to take the risk of embracing enthusiasm, joyfulness, and love. Working on the play, I came to see a metaphor in River City; in its stifled, reserved and sedate people, the place seemed to represent the challenges of aging itself, the tendency of seniors to censor themselves, cut themselves off from connection, to retreat and withdraw. You might say: lowa is Old Age.

Covid, of course, created a widespread combination of isolation, inertia, loneliness, particularly among the older population. It made the inherent difficulties of aging even harder. The resurrection of this project is a welcome opportunity for our company to perform its story and so, shake off torpor and return to creative self-expression, engagement, and celebration. The recession of Covid and re-start of *The Music Man SR*. have come together to create what I hope is an enjoyable, meaningful, cathartic experience for our cast, crew, and you, the audience. I want to thank Rose Ginsberg, Jessica Leylavergne, Amanda Gerulski and the support staff at Lenox Hill Neighborhood House; MTI, and, in particular, Freddie Gershon for his invaluable advice and support; Kevin Hull, our excellent musical director; Stage Manager Lupa Aguilar; and especially, the actors for their talent, patience, and adventurousness.

After years of shut-down, *The Music Man SR*. might help us all to awaken and hear again, in the words of Meredith Willson's song "Till There Was You": the bells on the hill, the birds in the sky, love all around: the Music of Life
